North Quay – South Quay – Bulwer Avenue – Les Banques – Gategny Esplanade

15.20 St Peter Port to St Martin

Weighbridge Roundabout – St Julian's Avenue – The Grange – The Queen's Road – Prince Albert's Road – Colborne Road – Fort Road – Route de Sausmarez

15.30 St Martin to Forest

La Grande Rue – La Rue Maze – La Route des Cornus – Route de La Foret – Le Chene – Le Bourg

15.35 Forest to St. Pierre du Bois
